LIFE IN THE BUILDING



The addition of a facility has made an immediate impact on the life of our ministry in numerous ways. For the first time in over eight years, our weekly worship and our men's and women's ministries have been in the same location from week to week. Along with that we have been able to resurrect Noonday lunch on Wednesdays; every week 160-200 students come to our building for a free meal. This has given us the opportunity to meet both physical and spiritual needs of students on a weekly basis and has helped us interact with students who previously had no contact with BCM. Through the the Lord's power, we've seen those interactions lead to salvations and increased attendance in the rest of our weekly ministries. As students continue to find their way to BCM, our weekly worship service, Crossroads, has averaged 125 students through the spring semester and continues to grow. Please pray that BCM students would continue to reach out to those on our campus that need Jesus, and that those students would come, believe, and belong!

BUILDING DEDICATION

On March 9th at 3 PM, a Dedication Service was held in our brand new facility! 335 people consisting of students, alumni, former staff, and local church members were in attendance for a time of worship and fellowship. The day served as a stark reminder of the breadth of the support for this ministry that has made such a facility possible. Through the various struggles SE BCM has endured over the 8.5 years of functioning without a facility, March 9th will always be a reminder of God's faithfulness towards this ministry and his mission on this campus. Staff and students alike walked away from the day encouraged to walk in obedience to carry on the legacy of gospel ministry on campus that has been happening since 1943. A special thank you to all who volunteered their time, energy, and resources to make BCM's new facility a reality! God already has...and will continue to use it for His glory in powerful ways.
